Point System

GOYA is a well rounded program for our Youth. We try to stress the importance of all programs and activities available. GOYANs have an opportunity to participate in such things as Religious programs, Sports activities, Cultural programs, Community Service activities, and Social Dances. To give you credit for the activities and programs you attend and participate in, your Spiritual Advisor and GOYA Advisors have decided on the following POINT SYSTEM.

Point totals will be considered for elections and for participation in "Mr. & Miss. GOYA." To be eligible to run for the Board, you must be a HS Junior or Senior in the upcoming year. If there are no Juniors in any given year, Sophomores will be considered. If you previously held a Board position, you cannot run for the same position again, unless there is no one else running for that position. A minimum of 35 points is needed to run for office and the Mr. & Miss.
